Farm Club at Broughton Grounds Farm, North Newington

Farm club takes place once a month (on 3rd Saturday) 9.45am-11.45am at Broughton Grounds Farm, North Newington. The next session is on Saturday 21st February. The cost is £5 per child (adults/carers are free of charge). Siblings are also welcome. There is a limit of 15 children per session and places must be booked and paid for in advance.

The visit is entirely a sensory, hands-on session for all children with additional needs, particularly those who enjoy/would benefit from sensory activities. It's based on a working farm and there is a purpose built classroom with hand washing area and disabled toilet facilities. Most areas are accessible by a concrete path suitable for wheelchairs, walkers, etc and they're currently fundraising to build a similar path to enable full access to the hen houses.

Previous sessions have involved watching sheep shearing, then using wool to make felt pictures, making bird feeders, autumn painting/collages, collecting hens eggs, feeding cows, pigs and geese, grinding wheat and making pancakes, wildflower walks, tractor rides, pond dipping, planting seeds, potatoes and an apple tree!
